Plug the DC Power cord into the cigarette lighter or auxillary DC power supply.



Now that you have unpacked each box, you have everything you need to start using your OxyGo (1400-1000). The set-up of your OxyGo is quick and simple. However, before using the OxyGo, please read the entire User Manual.

Place your OxyGo in a well ventilated location. Ensure both particle filters are in place.





Connect the AC Power Supply cord to the OxyGo.



Plug the Power Supply AC cord into the nearest electrical outlet.



Connect the nasal cannula tubing into the metal nozzle on your OxyGo. Oxygen will only be delivered while you are breathing through the nasal cannula connected to the device.



Turn on the OxyGo by pressing the button.



Set the flow setting to the flow rate prescribed by your clinical professional. The flow setting can be changed by pressing the triangular flow setting buttons that are marked with "+" and "-" symbols. Position the nasal cannula on your face and breathe normally through your nose.
